

## SIERRA WINTER CLASSIC GENERAL SHOW RULES

1. All Steers exhibitors must be 19 years old and under as of January 1, 2011. All Heifer exhibitors must be 21 years old and under as of January 1, 2011.
2. **Entries must be postmarked by January 5, 2011.** Entry Fees must accompany Entry, \$35 per head, \$5 Per Showmanship Division. **Non- Refundable.** Please make checks payable to: **Porterville Fair-SWC**

3. Entries postmarked after January 5, 2011, and any other late entries will be assessed an additional \$25/hd late charge, late entries will be accepted until 8:00 P.M. on Friday, January 14, 2011 for Jackpot Steers and 4:00 P.M. Saturday, January 15, 2011 for Heifers. **No special provisions for stall space will be made for late entries.**
4. Arrivals will be accepted starting at 8:00 A.M., Friday.
5. **STEER WEIGH-IN** will be at 6:00 P.M. to 8:30 P.M. on Friday Only.  
**HEIFER CHECK-IN** Any time prior to 2:00 P.M. on Saturday at the Office.
6. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal. **Unless approved by show manager.** CJLA rules apply for points.
7. Exhibitors ownership: Registration papers are required & must be presented at check-in. Bill of Sale may be required at weigh-in. **(All cattle must be accompanied by transportation papers that have been provided. Please keep transportation papers with your animal as you travel to & from SWC.**
8. There will be a mandatory exhibitor meeting Saturday at 9:00 A.M. in the show ring.
9. **Electric Power is Very Limited and you must bring a Generator to insure that you will not have to wait for power. Fuel cans must be kept outside the barn area.**
10. Class premiums will be paid on a percentage basis, only after show expenses are paid.
11. Special Awards for Champion and Reserve Heifer, Progress & Prospect Steer. Awards will be presented to breed Champions & Reserves. Class prizes will be awarded & premium money. First Place in Showmanship will receive Jacket & Premium money.
12. No uniform required, however exhibitors shall dress neat and clean while showing.
13. The Show Management reserves the right to interpret any and all rules and to change the show schedule and classes to improve the show.
14. The SIERRA WINTER CLASSIC and all those associated with the SIERRA WINTER CLASSIC will assume no responsibility for death or injury to livestock or persons or damage to property of others during those events held January 14-16, 2011.
15. **Shaving's only**, no other bedding allowed. Purchase of bedding will be available. First bedding will not be provided. **Exhibitors are responsible for removing any and all hay before leaving to designated dump areas. Failure to do so will cost you \$30/hd (to be deducted from premium checks.. This Rule will be enforced.**
16. No cattle will be released until the specified time. **No Exceptions**
17. Artificial means of filling cattle internally is prohibited.
18. **Porterville Fair policy prohibits the use of alcohol on the grounds. No smoking or dogs will be allowed in the barns area. Dogs shall only be allowed on the grounds if they are on a leash. Dog owners will accept all responsibility for any and all damages that may occur as a result of the animal being on the grounds.**

**STEER SHOW RULES**  
**PROGRESS STEERS & PROSPECT STEERS**

1. Progress Steer division 900 lbs. and over.
2. Prospect Steer division 899 lbs. and under.
3. Progress Steer Show - Saturday starting at 9:30 A.M.
4. Prospect Steer Show - Saturday following CCCA Show
5. Weight Classes will be determined only after all steers are weighed-in. No re-weighs.
6. Champion Prospect Steer and Champion Progress Steer will not compete against each other.
7. Showmanship for all Steers will follow the selection of the Champion Progress Steer.
8. CCCA Special Class
9. **Release Time -Anyone wishing to leave can do so after the Prospect Steer Show has concluded.**

**HEIFER SHOW RULES**

1. Heifer show will start at 9:00 A.M. Sunday.
2. There must be at least 10 heifers of one breed to constitute their own breed show; otherwise they will be shown as Straight English Bred Heifers or as All Other Breed Heifers.
3. Cow-Calf Class: Cow/calf class can be of any age, but cow must be lactating, all breeds shown together.
4. Grade Heifer Class - (Non-registered heifers), need breed of sire & dam listed on entry form in lieu of name and registration number.
5. **A copy of the Registration papers must be mailed with entry.** Any heifer without registration papers will be placed in the grade class. (No Exceptions!). Pending Registration papers can be faxed from the Breed Association only to the fair office for heifers being shown in Breed classes. (Not Grade)
6. Heifers must have an Ear Tattoo and vaccination against Brucellosis.
7. Heifer showmanship to follow the selection of Supreme Heifer.
8. **Release Time: All remaining Animals will be released following the conclusion of the show. No Exceptions.**

**SHOWMANSHIP RULES**

1. Entry fee \$5 per Division. No uniforms required.
2. Animal & exhibitor must have competed together in class to be eligible for showmanship.
3. There will be 2 separate showmanship divisions consisting of Heifers, Steers.
4. **All exhibitors must show their own animals. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
5. Showmanship contest 3 Divisions for Steers (Junior 9-12, Intermediate 13- 15 year, and Senior 16-19) 3 Divisions for Heifers (Junior 9-12, Intermediate 13-15 year, and Senior 16-21).
